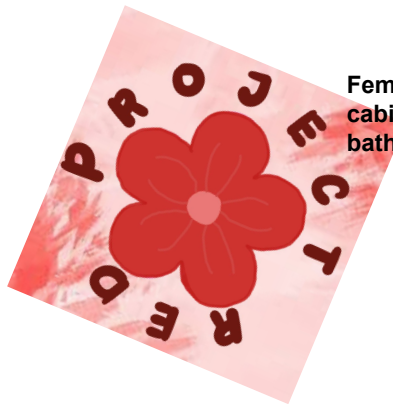

What is a charter school?

- Public:
 - Tuition-free
 - Accountable
 - Open to all students
 - Flexibility and innovation

What is a charter school?

- Tuition-Free
 - Publicly funded



✂ What is a charter school?

- Public school funding
 - The state gives funds for each student.
 - Those funds go to the public school the student attends.



✂ What is a charter school?



- Elementary schools receive about \$9,000 per student.

What is a charter school?



- 1% for Authorizer Oversight Fees

✂ What is a charter school?



- 1% for Authorizer Oversight Fees
- And ~18% for our facility rental & mortgage

What is a charter school?



- Traditional public school receive this, and:
 - Facilities funding
 - Transportation funding
 - Often additional supplemental funding

What is a charter school?

- **Open to all students**
 - No admissions criteria
 - Anyone can apply
 - We do not gather any information prior to the enrollment

What is a charter school?

- **Accountable**

- Common Core State Standards
- All other state reporting
- LCAPs
- Also accountable to authorizer:
 - Charter renewal every 5 (7?) years

What is a charter school?

- **Flexible and innovative**
 - Core Knowledge
 - Teachers are empowered to make decisions
 - Making a real impact on student achievement

Changes in the Law

- New changes that have impacted our schools
 - Renewals are potentially challenging
 - New schools will be much more challenging
 - American River Collegiate Academy
 - RA Gateway charter

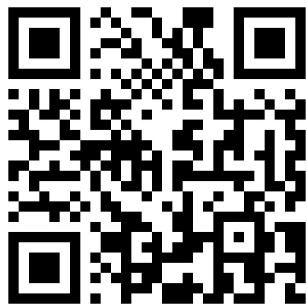
