## **RA GATEWAY ART DOCENT FAQ 2022**

- 1. What do Art Docents do? Teach art appreciation and lead an art project to students. Project should highlight arts over crafts.
- 2. What do they teach? Themed art lessons are prepared by the program, but you are free to create your own art projects related to the lesson.
- 3. Do docents need an art degree? No! A passion for arts and kids is all you need!
- 4. Do docents have to be parents? No! Grandparents have volunteered in the past.
- 5. How often are the lessons and how long? Lessons are once a month, approx. 1hr to 1hr 15mins long. Art presentation (discussion on 5 art pieces) run about 15 mins and the art projects are usually 45-60 mins.
- 6. Who provides the art supplies? The program has art paper, construction paper, tempera paint, watercolors, chalk pastel, crayons, markers, and more!
- 7. Who keeps the artwork? You may discuss with teachers to temporarily display on walls, but docents keep all the art until core knowledge night in May.
  - a. Docent keep an art portfolio for each student (typically home made out of brown grocery bag).
